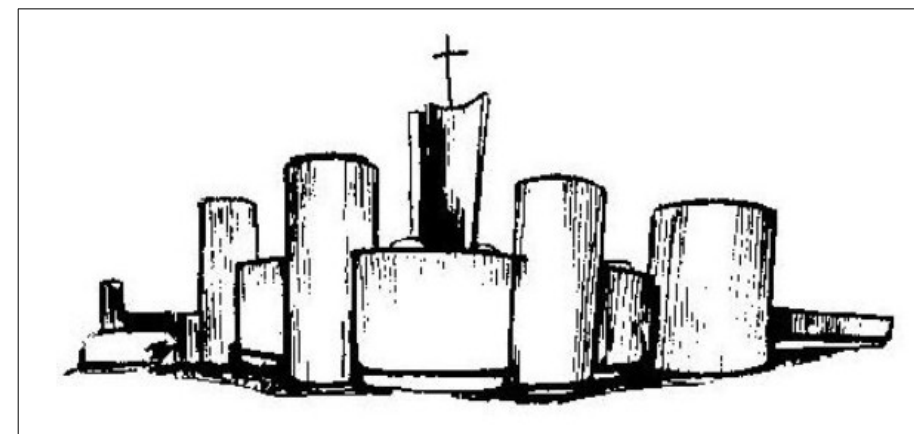

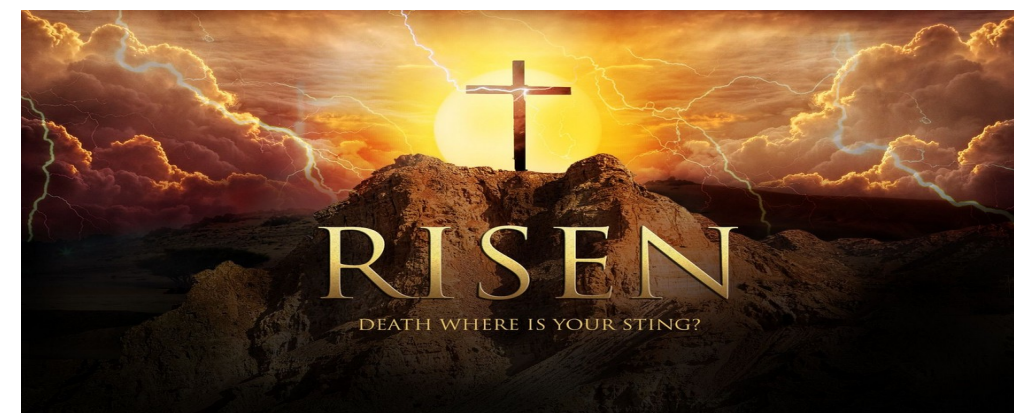

There are specific questions we must ask you and some information that we must give you. A phone call is required. The protocols state that in order to sit in the same pew in the church, you must live under the same roof; therefore, please register accordingly.
