

An Update on the Fund-tasia Campaign

Thank you one and all for supporting the Fund-tasia campaign!

The campaign included the launch, the St Augustine Walk with Minta event, the classical concert and the *Flavours of Italy* supper. Together the campaign raised a total of \$30,793 with \$7,032 (after expenses) from the events and \$23,761 from donations to date. We do have a promise of an additional \$7000.00.

This would not have been possible without the precious participation of our Honorary President Louise Fleischmann and the many volunteers who stepped up to help our cause.

Based on the church's current architectural report completed in 2017 we require \$56,000 (our 30% portion) to complete Phase 2: the narthex & rectory roofs, refinishing the wooden doors around the church and other smaller projects. This amount could change as a mandatory update to our architectural report will be produced this fall. A lot can change in 5 years!

In September we will start a pledging campaign similar to what was done in 2020 to raise the remaining funds. Stay tuned!
