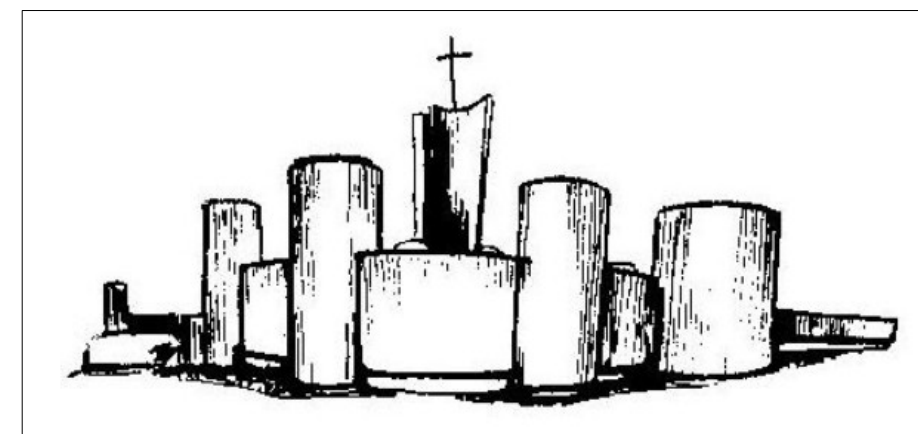

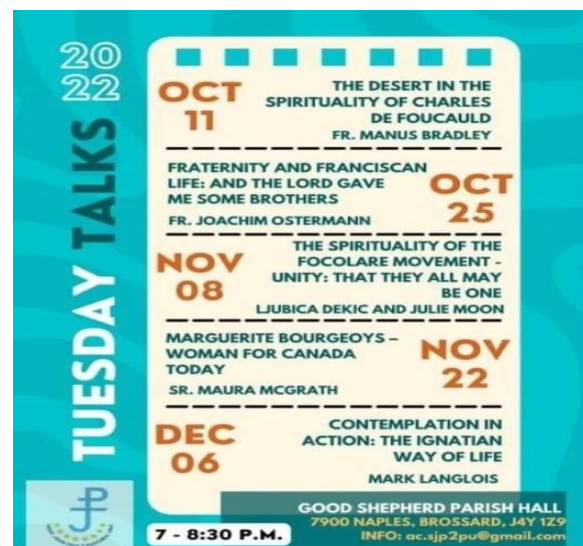
The Pope's Prayer Intention for November

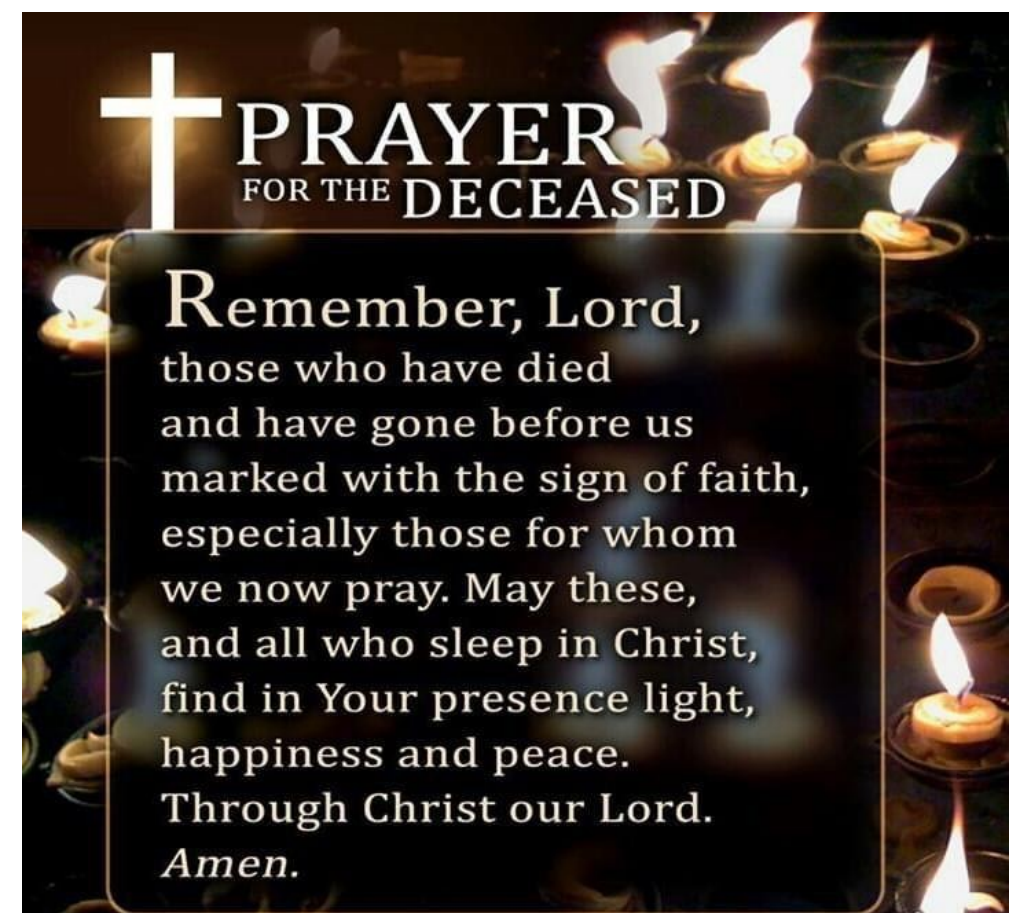
Heritage Project

On Tuesday Oct. 4th the architects came to St. Augustine to conduct the complete inspection of our church in order to produce the Phase 2 Health Report (Carnet de Santé). We expect the completed report in the next few weeks and once obtained we will be able to prepare the scope of our next request for funding.
