

Heritage Project - Update

In July 2022, we provided an update on our Fund-Tasia campaign. At the time of writing, we had raised \$30793. With additional donations received since then, the total amount raised in 2022 was \$41081. Summary:

\$89284 Donations Sept 2020 – Dec 2022

\$85668 CPRQ funds received

\$ 7212 GST/PST Rebate 2021

\$182164 Total

- \$135194 Less costs (Roof, architects fees, new inspection report)

\$46970 Funds available in Heritage fund for next phase

The new inspection report (Carnet de Santé) was received Dec 17th, 2022. We are working with the architects to prioritize the work for this year based on our current funds. More details will be communicated to parishioners in the coming weeks. Request for 2023 government (CPRQ) funding must be submitted by the end of February. We will know by May/June whether funding has been approved and will proceed accordingly. If you have any questions, please contact Mary Clermont.

Spiritual Tourism and St. Augustine Church

Did you know that the spiritual tourism industry is growing at a healthy rate and that 86% of Quebec tourists will visit a religious site even if they do not practice any form of religion? If you were visiting a foreign country, chances are you would tour at least one church. The interest to highlight the religious sites in the Montérégie area to meet this growing demand is the engine behind this exciting new project for St. Augustine's.

The spiritual tourism project was spearheaded by Tourism Montéregie and the ATSRQ (Association Tourism Spiritual et Religieux du Quebec) in early 2022. As a classified church we were invited to attend the initial meeting and quickly realized the potential for St Augustine. Pamela Gunning stepped up as a volunteer for this project and in collaboration with the Fabrique will lead the initiative in 2023. The result of the 2022 five work sessions was to create two touristic circuits: "People" and "Places".

St. Augustine will be part of the "Places" circuit with seven other religious

- 1. Saint-Antoine de Padoue Co-cathedral (Longueuil)
- 2. Sainte-Marguerite d'Youville Sanctuaire (Varennes)
- 3. St-Augustine de Canterbury (St. Bruno de Montarville)
- 4. Manoir D'Youville (Chateauguay)
- 5. Église de l'Acadie (St. Jean-sur-Richelieu)
- 6. Lieux Historiques des Soeurs des Saints Noms de Jesus et de Marie (Longueuil)
- 7. Saint-Denis-sur-Richelieu Church (St. Denis-sur-Richelieu)
- 8. Cathédrale de Saint-Hyacinthe

2023 will be a trial year starting on June 1st and ending on Oct 31st.

A project of this size will bring visibility and revenues to our church as the tours are expected to be made up of groups from Quebec, Canada and the world. The Manoir Youville will act as a reservation contact for travel agents wishing to set up tours and will also manage the distribution of revenues for each church.
