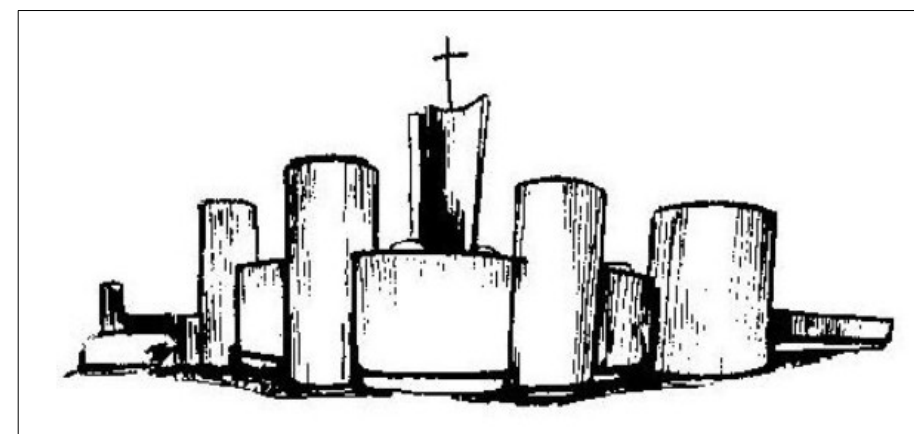

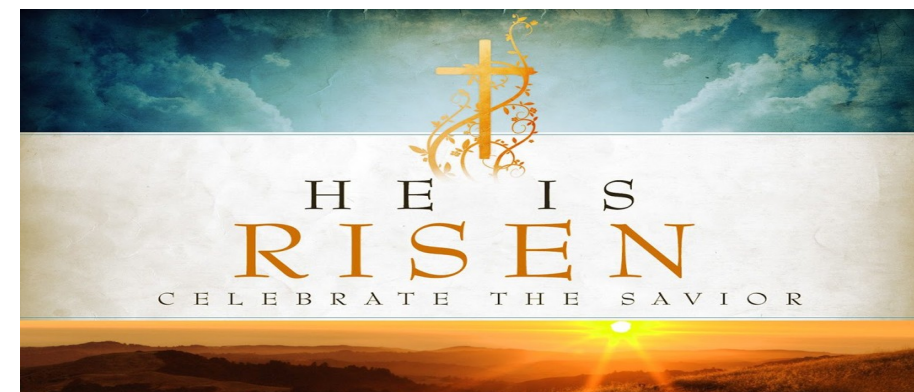

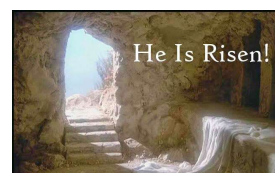

Pastor's Easter Message 2023



There is an ancient Celtic prayer that begins like this, "I rise with you, dear Jesus, and you rise with me". The prayer goes on to describe how the oil of gladness poured on Jesus at his burial, trickles down on us; that the fire of love that burned in the heart of Jesus warms our hearts; that the Word of God uttered by Jesus, is written forever on the

foreheads of those who believe. It speaks of the resurrection as something that is ongoing, not a once-off event, but as something that continues to unfold in the lives of Christ's followers each day.

The resurrection of Christ is personal; it affects each of us, it involves each one of us. The oil of gladness is shared, the love of God is shared, the Word of God is shared and is alive in the hearts of believers, allowing each of us to be partakers in the life of resurrection, the life of the church, and in the life of the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom or reign of God is fully realized in Christ's resurrection, which allows us to experience not only the resurrection of the dead but daily resurrection, an ongoing experience of being raised up in Christ.

This Easter we rejoice in Christ's resurrection from the dead as the promise of our ultimate resurrection at the end of time, but we also rejoice every time we overcome sin, fear, doubt, hatred, and anger, and rise to newness of life in Christ through our daily attempts to live as his graced disciples.

I wish all the members of the eight parishes of the Saint John Paul II Pastoral Unit a very Happy Easter. May we rise with Christ each day.
