

## The Most Holy Trinity June 4

The making of the sign of the cross, which professes faith in the redemption of Christ and in the Trinity, dates from the earliest centuries. Before receiving the sacrament of baptism, Christians respond to a 3-part question when asked to witness their faith in the Father, the Son and the Spirit by saying "I do." The faith of all Christians rests on the Trinity. Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: not in their own names, for there is only one God, the almighty Father, his only Son and the Holy Spirit: the Most Holy Trinity. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith". The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin".

# THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (Corpus Christi) June 8

"THIS IS MY BODY, THIS IS MY BLOOD"

The feast of Corpus Christi, or the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, celebrates the institution of the sacrament of Holy Communion at the Last Supper. In 1264, Pope Urban IV established the Feast of Corpus Christi as an universal feast of the Church to be celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday.



"The Church draws her life from the Eucharist. This truth does not simply express a daily experience of faith, but recapitulates the heart of the mystery of the Church. In a variety of ways she joyfully experiences the constant fulfillment of the promise: "Lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age" (Mt 28:20), but in the Holy Eucharist, through the changing of bread and wine into the body and blood of the Lord, she rejoices in this presence with unique intensity. Ever since Pentecost, when the Church, the People of the New Covenant, began her pilgrim journey towards her

heavenly homeland, the Divine Sacrament has continued to mark the passing of her days, filling them with confident hope." ~ Pope St. John Paul II
