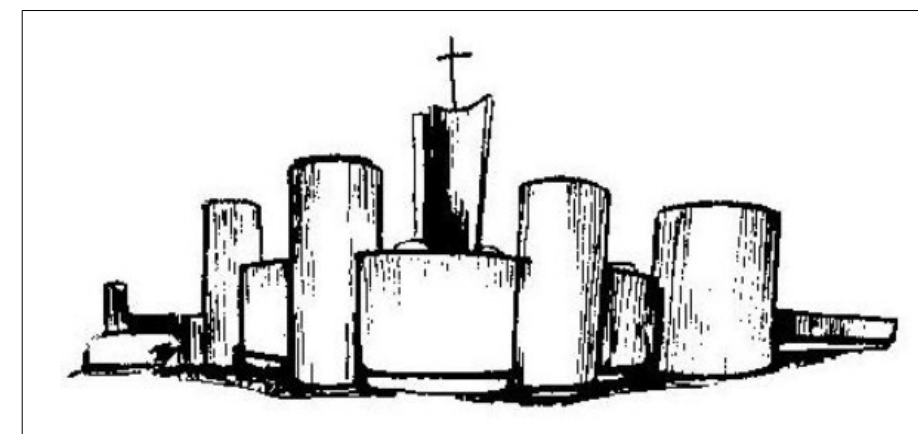

Prayer for Departed Souls – November 2

November is an important time of year for commemoration in Canada: On the second of the month, we celebrate All Souls Day, on which we remember all the deceased. On the 11th, we celebrate Remembrance Day, in honour of those who gave their lives for our country.

In fact, the whole month of November is dedicated to remembering the dead. What does it mean to remember the deceased? We recall first of all that we are the Body of Christ and that our family also includes those who have gone before us. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that through the Communion of Saints, "a perennial link of charity exists between the faithful who have already reached their heavenly home, those expiating their sins in Purgatory and those who are still pilgrims on earth.
