# The Holv Week

Holy Week enables us to walk step by step with Jesus through His Passion. Beginning with Palm Sunday, we literally greet Christ in His procession into Jerusalem with palms, along with the crowds and children, singing Hosanna and acclaiming Christ's kingship. We recognize that the blessed one who comes in the name of the Lord has entered into our midst. Palm Sunday becomes Passion Sunday as we read the Gospel account of the Passion.

Holy Thursday, begins the great liturgical drama of the Triduum. Jesus invites us into His mission of self-gift for others, flowing from the Father's love. We commemorate the great gifts of the priesthood and the Eucharist. At the end of the Holy Thursday Mass we begin our accompaniment of Jesus through His Passion. His sacramental body is processed away from the altar, representing His captivity, as it is stripped, and conveyed through a solemn procession to the altar of repose, to keep watch even for one hour.

Good Friday celebrates the Lord's passion, with three major parts: the proclamation of the Passion, the veneration of the Cross, and the reception of Holy Communion.

The Easter Vigil begins with the Service of Light, the lighting of the Easter Candle and the singing of the Easter Proclamation, the Exsultet. Then after an extended Liturgy of the Word, the Vigil continues with the Liturgy of Baptism during which the Litany of Saints is sung, the water of the font is blessed, baptismal promises are made.

Easter Sunday is the daytime celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord. The church is festively decorated. The vestments are white and gold. The Glory to God and the Alleluia are restored. The Creed is replaced with the renewal of baptismal promises, followed by a sprinkling rite. The church resounds with a joyful sound: Jesus Christ is risen today! Alleluia!
