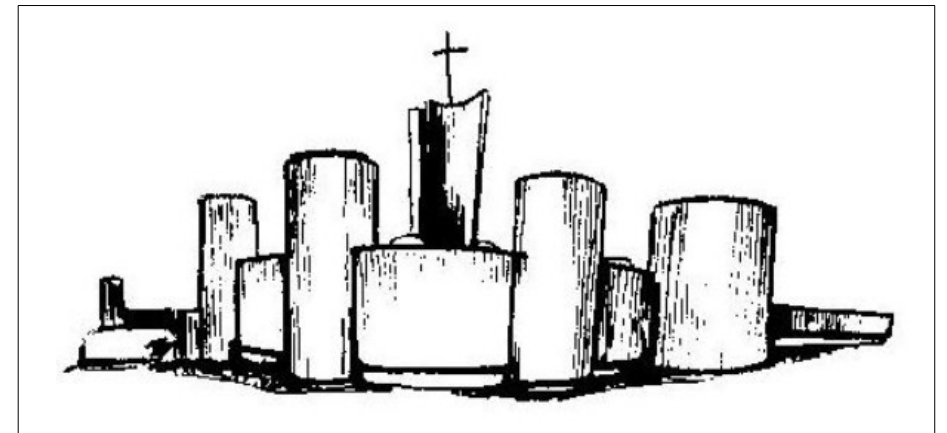

Saturday, May 11th from 10 am to noon: Tomato plants, herbs, vegetable plants, geraniums and other annuals

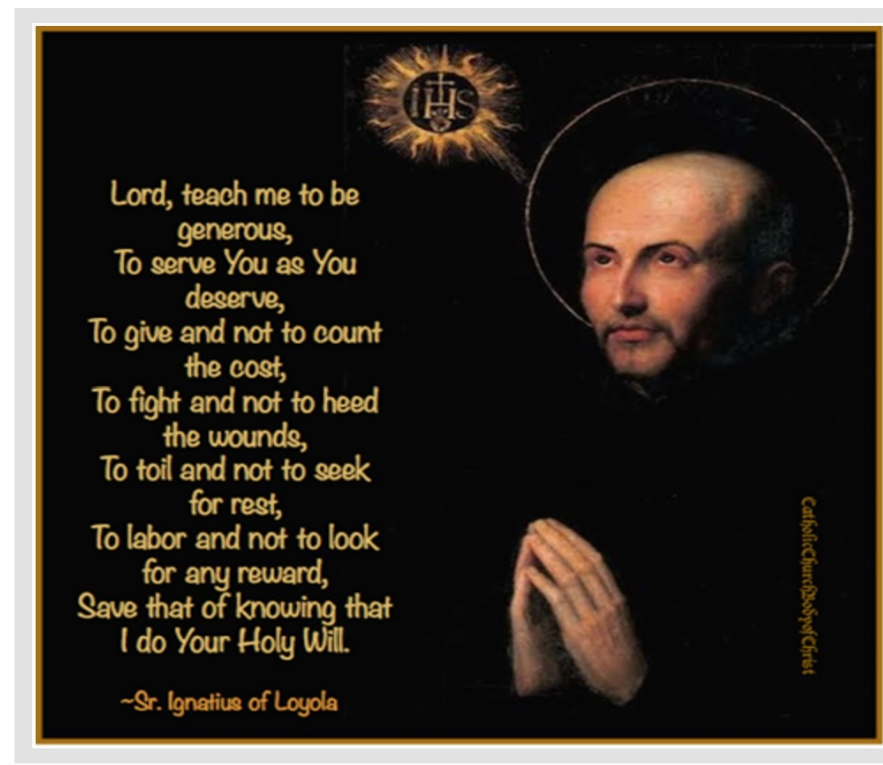
Saturday, June 8th: Perennials, annuals, and indoor plants. 10 am to 2 pm.

Things to know about Divine Mercy Sunday

1. What is Divine Mercy Sunday?

It is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. It is based on the private revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska, which recommended a particular devotion to the Divine Mercy. It also has links to the Bible and the readings of this day.

2. When was it made part of the Church's calendar?

In 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and, during the ceremony, he declared: "It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday'"
