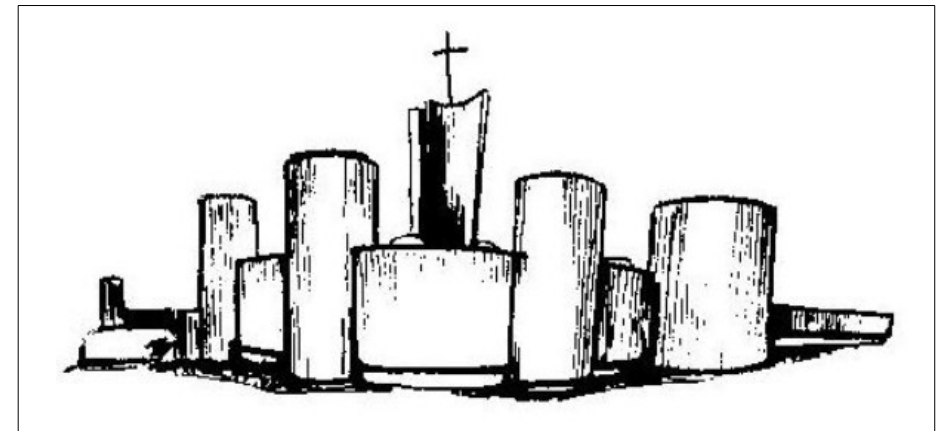

WORDS TO LIVE BY

“The joy of faith is not about all the things that we can accomplish, but about knowing that God is ever close to us, that he loved us first, and that he accompanies us every day of our lives.
